lectmen of the fame town or district, recommending them as follows, viz.

Form.

WE, the subscribers, Selectmen of the town (or district) of do approve of (inferting the name of the person and the employment for which he or she is approbated) in the faid town (or district) for the year enfuing; and we do hereby recommend the faid as a person of sober life and conversation, suitably qualified and provided for the exercise of such an employment, and firmly attached to the Constitution and laws of this Commonwealth.

Duty of Selectmen.

And it shall be the duty of the Selectmen in the several towns, annually, to certify to the Court of the General Sessions of the Peace, at the beginning of their term for granting licenses, what number of innholders and retailers, in their respective towns, they judge to be necessary for the public good. No license shall that no license be renewed to any person who shall have been be renewed to before licenfed, against whom any presentment, complaint, or persons who information shall be made for misrule or disorder in such house, stand present. or for not being suitably provided as the law in such case requires to entertain strangers and travellers at bed and board, before the matter complained of and informed against be inquired into and judged of. Provided, Such presentment or complaint be profecuted to effect at or before the same Court for granting fuch licenses; unless the prosecution be delayed at the motion of the perion applying for the license.

SECT. 3. Be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid. And every licensed victualler, innholder, or taverner, shall, at all times, have a board or sign affixed to his or her house, or in some conspicuous place near the fame, with his or her name at large thereon, and the particular employment for which he or she is licensed: And if any victualler, innholder, or taverner, enjoined by law to be fuitably provided to receive and entertain strangers, travellers or others, as occasion may require, shall be convicted of refusing to make fuitable provision when defired, for the receiving of strangers, travellers, and their horses and cattle, or for any public entertainment, fuch person, upon being convicted thereof before the Justices of the General Sessions of the Peace of the county to which fuch person belongs, shall, by the said Justices, be deprived of his or her license; and the faid Justices shall be and they are hereby empowered and directed to order the Sheriff
