

Item, I Give to the Children, and heirs of my Brother John Wells late of Deerfield deceased all my right and Intrest in and unto the lands that lie in the North half of the additional grant of lands so called in Deerfield afore said, viz my Lot in the first and my lot in the second division of P^s lands to them and their heirs forever

Item I Give to my Brother Jonathan Wells of Hatfield all my Comandos or Comono Rights in all the undivided Lands in Deerfield afore P^s to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give to each of the Children of my Sister Mary Graves the late wife of Aaron Graves thirty shillings to be paid them out of the remaining part of my Estate By my Executors

Item I Give to Elizabeth Wells the Daughter of my Brother Joshua Wells six pounds thirte shillings and four pence to be paid her out of the remaining part of my Estate as afore P^s

Item I Give to Elizabeth the wife of Nathaniel Phelps of Northampton, thirteen pounds six shillings and eight pence, I also give to the ~~same~~ ^{sons} of the P^s Elizabeth Phelps thirteen pounds six shillings and eight pence to be paid to each of them By my Executors as afore P^s

and as for all the remaining part of my Estate whether Real or Personal that is not already disposed of By this my last will and Testament I Give and bequeath the whol and Every part and parcel thereof unto my nephew Eben^r Wells of Deerfield the Son of my Brother Tho^s Wells late of Deerfield deceased to him the P^r Eben^r his heirs and assigns forever and Lastly I constitute ordain and appoint my Beloved wife Abigail and my P^r Stephen Eben^r Wells of Deerfield Executors of this my Last will and Testament and I do by these presents revoke disanul and utterly make void all and any former will and Testament at any times here to fore made or ordained and I do also hereby ratify and confirm and declare this instrument to be my Last will and Testament in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal the day and Year first written, signed sealed published and declared by the P^r Eben^r Wells to be his Last will and Testament in presence of us who subscribed as witnesses in the presence of the Testator
